Dear Listener,

Radio Na Gael was first started on 92.2 FM on 2nd February 1984. It has gone a long way since then.

It is now Broadcasting 24 Hours a day on 92.2 FM and 1350 KHZ Medium Wave and 6340 KHZ Short Wave World Wide.

Radio Na Gael is now very popular with Irish people working overseas, and people of Irish descent World Wide.

North County Dublin and Dublin City is covered on local Radio Na Gael - 95% Irish Music 24 Hours a day with local announcements.

Advertising is kept at a minimum covering the cost of running the station only as Radio Na Gael is strictly a non-profitmaking station dedicated to the music of Ireland, and in educating the young people of Ireland at Home and overseas in their native music and song.

Radio Na Gael is the only station in Ireland Broadcasting on Short Wave 24 hours day.

We have letters confirming our Reception in Britain, Australia, USSR, Poland, USA, Canada, Greenland, New Guinea, France, Malta, India, Pakistan and Rio.

We are Broadcasting on Transmitters of 10 Watt FM 200 Watt Medium Wave 500 Watt Short Wave, all our transmitters were built by Q & N Electronics - Casa Mia, Mountgorry, Swords, County Dublin Eire.

We would also recommend you listen to local station Radio Phoenix on 7306 KHZ, it is Broadcasting on Sunday mornings and occasionally at night.
